Simeon W. Garriott passed away peacefully into the presence of his Lord, on April 12th 2016, at the age of 88 years old. He was born in Calgary Alberta and grew up on the family farm near Strathmore, Alberta, moving to Calgary with his parents when they retired in the 1940's. In 1949, he joined the R.C.A.F. for nine years of service, stationed in Edmonton. Simeon was responsible for packing parachutes and safety equipment. When Simeon left the service, he became a printer, later working at UBC Health Science Hospital in Vancouver for over 20 years.
