Ada Ziefflie 98, passed away peacefully in Mission, BC, March 21, 2017, with her family by her side. She was born January 11, 1919 in Davidson, Saskatchewan to Cyril Jules Vanghel and Philomena Brigitta (Nuyttens) Vanghel. She was predeceased by husband Ruben Ziefflie in 1984; sons Fred Ziefflie in 1972, Ken Ziefflie in 2005, and Donald Ziefflie in 2012.
