Hardy Joseph Sullivan

April 3, 1933 - November 6, 2017



Hardy Joseph Sullivan, 84, born April 3rd 1933, died Nov 6th 2017 at Surrey Memorial Hospital. He leaves behind his 2 remaining sisters, Jeannie and Margaret; 4 children, Kelly, Kim, Kurt and Paul; 9 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren, and many relatives and friends. He was the 13th child of Jean and Jerry Sullivan from which the Sullivan Station of Surrey BC was named. His family owned the Sullivan General Store and Post Office at 152nd and 64th for many years. He played football for the newly formed Surrey Rams and for the A League Hillside Dairy basketball team in Cloverdale as a young man. He spent 35 years with BC Telephone climbing poles and fixing the old PBX boards before computers took over until he retired.
